## Park Fest 2020 canceled, Home Tour rescheduled to help manage COVID-19

#### A message from the leadership team:

Palo Verde Park Neighborhood works hard to create a collective sense of ownership in our park, a sense of reverence around public art, beauty and nature, and a strong commitment to community.


We have watched the developments around COVID-19 closely, and believe we have a responsibility to follow the guidance of our public health and elected leaders as they work to manage the spread of this disease.

With the Mayor's recent recommendation against large public gatherings of 50 people or more, we have determined the responsible path is to cancel Park Fest 2020, with the possibility of rescheduling later in the year.

We have also rescheduled our Midcentury Modified Home Tour, which will now take place on May 31, when we hope a sense of normalcy has been restored.

At this point, we also are hopeful that the threat of transmission will be reduced enough by May that our summer movie night series may proceed as well.

We appreciate your understanding and patience as we navigate this unexpected development.






## New infrastructure projects coming to Palo Verde Park


Palo Verde Park Neighborhood Association is working to bring new infrastructure projects to the park.


