The Palo Verde Park project is going well and is on track to complete by the Memorial Day target, according to the project manager.

Some of the electrical switch gear equipment components, however, are long-lead items and may delay our ability to actually turn the lights on by the planned completion date, even though they expect the lights and light poles themselves to be in place this spring.

Underway: trenching and placing pipe and conduit for electric and irrigation, setting forms for concrete at pickleball, and completing the stub-out for the stormwater basin across Langley.
