## Steer Clear of Labyrinth Area East of Park on July 21

Next Saturday, July 21, the Tucson Bird Alliance will be out at the site to perform a targeted herbicide spray on invasive grass species.

They will likely be out in the morning to spray and it is best to wait until the herbicide is dry to enter or use the site. That's a minimum of four hour, and even better to wait a good 24 hours for pets.



Meanwhile, if you haven't had a chance to try out the walking path around the labyrinth, check it out. It's still a work in progress, but the walking path is taking shape that will eventually span from the veteran's bridge and along the wash to the north.
